As of Friday, Bridget's mom is out of the leg immobilizer brace! Praise God! She is now allowed to begin therapy to strengthen her legs and begin the process of learning to walk on her own again. At this point she is still not able to bend the leg at all and movement is very difficult. Please keep her in your prayers as she goes through the rehab process. With complete ruptures of the tendon in each leg and the severe pain associated with that, this is as much a mental battle as it is physical as she progresses along the way.

Praising God for the opportunities He has given me to preach the Word and to encourage church families. Also, Bridget and the kids had an opportunity to assist with a local outreach event handing out gospel tracks. They had a few really good conversations and great fellowship. In addition to the ministry, Daniel and Cori were really encouraged as they were able to minister to some youth throughout the day.

Even though we are all disappointed to miss camps this summer, the kids have had the best attitudes and are making the most of it. Even this week, they went swimming and met a 15 year old boy. It turns out he is Jewish and when he heard they were from a Christian missionary family, he became very excited and had all kinds of questions for his new Christian friends. They had some good conversations about Jesus, the trinity, and a lot about the Old Testament. What a swin! And what a great opportunity to share about Jesus! Praise God! Please pray for them as they finish up their school year this week.
