Let me tell you how I actually found myself there. I was born in a orthodox family in which religion played an enormous role, there was no holiday, there were no rituals and prayers that my grandmother did not know by heart, she constantly prayed and went to church to praise God. When I began to realize the world around me she began to tell me about God and his abundant blessings, for His power and greatness. When I started my elementary school, I realized that few people know what I knew and with each conversation on that topic I was ridiculed and that made

me very sad. There were times when I even thought that all these things about God were invented by my grandmother. In 6th grade for the first time in the school they introduced a subject about Religion and I was thrilled that I will learn more about God not only from my grandmothers mouth but from the books. Unfortunately my grandmother suddenly dies, and since she was the only thing that has tied me to that world, I remain halfway. So, a long period of time has passed since I've heard someone else to talk about God as my grandmother did. Then I realized that God did not give up on me and He constantly worked in my life and sought a way to meet again.

So in the summer of 2015 I went to a English camp called Speak Out organized by Every Student (Cru). When I went there I thought it was like every summer camp. But from the entrance of the hotel I was welcomed by people who changed my life. They were gentle people, full of life, self-confidence, constantly smiling and ready to help, they were different people. During that week I realized that those people are different because their personal relationship with God and that all those virtues were given by Him. Since then, I have actively joined Every student and I have been part of every workshop they organize. This year I am also involved in organizing and leading the weekly events. I have mentorship with one of the staff, Maya who in some way replaced my grandmother. She is helping me in my walk with God and she is encouraging me to take steps of faith in many areas of my life. I am immensely thankful to God for not giving up on me and for leading me to Every Student where I got to know God personally and grow in my faith."

This year Mery is actively involved in all our activities and we are especially encouraged to see her going out on evangelism with other students. Hallelujah
