God is preparing our hearts for this mission and he is sending us among the Muslims. Please be in prayer that God will work even more in our hearts to have love for the Albanian people and to witness among Muslims about Christ. Pray for proper training that will help us to better connect with Muslims and to know how effectively to share the gospel. Personally, God is giving me a great

weight and a challenge to serve among Muslim Albanians in Macedonia. I am very sad that the ministry among Albanians has not seen any fruit yet, but I believe that God knows the time and the people who will believe in Christ. Our brothers and sisters who serve for 10 years among Muslim Albanians in Macedonia have not yet seen anyone to believe.
