He said, I am one of the "Lost Boys of Sudan." That references a huge group of young boys who were escaping the brutal civil war in their country by walking over a thousand miles to get to refugee camps in Kenya or Ethiopia. They stayed in the camps for many years and all the world seemed to forget them. Yet, they grew up, and a few won the chance to get into the USA. There is a movie made about them. Peter was one of the few chosen. A family sponsored him and took him into their home. Then Peter attended Western Michigan University, and after graduation moved to Florida for the warmer weather. He worked for a Lutheran agency helping refugees currently coming to the USA. Recently, the funding was cut and he lost his job. He is writing his memoirs and looking for a job where he can both make money and have an impact for Jesus. It is such a privilege to help him find meaningful employment, to eat dinner with him, and just to listen to him outline God's hand in his story. Please pray for the Lord to lead Peter to find the best job to meet his current needs and make a positive impact for Christ.
