Opening for Worship at 9:30 a.m. Sunday, June 7th

Live streaming will be available for those choosing to stay home

Rules for attending church worship services:

Safe distancing at all times.....No contact please.

Enter and exit the church by the back door only. No greeters.

Please use hand sanitizer provided as you enter.

Seating will be every other pew with 1 family group per $\frac{1}{2}$ pew which means you may not be able to sit in your usual pew.

No Bulletin: The order of service will be projected on the screen.

No special music at this time.

We will not be singing our congregational hymns aloud as usual – but familiar hymns will be shared by Deb so we can worship the Lord in our minds and hearts during those times.

The offering plate will be placed in the vestibule to place your offering in at the end of the service. Dismissing will be done from the back to the front.

Our restrooms will be for emergency use only so plan accordingly.

There will be NO Jr. Church or Sunday school at this time.
