This story begins a few years ago when I met Nikolche at the college during a random evange-lism. I shared the gospel with him and he believed in Jesus! We started to have regular discipleship and as he was learning about God and growing in his faith he shared about Jesus with his roommate Mile. Mile believed and the two of them together with other students joined a Bible study group that I was leading in the dormitory where they lived. You might remember Nikolche and Mile from this picture! The story of salvation goes on. Mile got involved in all our activities with Cru and he begin to witness to his sister Verche. After some time she also become a believer. Hallelujah! We are so encouraged by God's way of salvation. God hears our prayers!



This is Verche story with her own words:

Before I became a believer I have never prayed to God, because if you are Orthodox you only go to church for a holidays and you are only taught that there is God. Every time I would go to church I would feel that peace in my soul and a certain dose of humility, but at no point did I realize it in the true sense of the word. I think it was kind of superficial. As I was brought up, I adhered to some "rules", so as not to make many mistakes, but I never tried to obey God's rules and to live in accordance with what God commands us, because I had no example from whom to learn.

But fortunately, since my brother Mile believed, he never gave up talking with me about God. I have to admit, I was bored at times, but I still listened to him. He had problems at home because our parents didn't want to accept the fact that my brother believes in God and they thought it was something bad. Every time he would come back home from Skopje he would not miss an opportunity to share about God with me. I am greatly thankful to God for not giving up on me besides that I was not obedient and did not even try to get to know Him and to do the things that pleased Him.

When I started the college in Skopje I joined Every Student (my last summer in high school I was camper at Speak Out, so I knew many of the students and staff from Cru), and I simply felt that I belonged there among those people. It was hard for me to separate from my parents and the fact that I should start taking care for myself, but God turned every bad to good. Milena— staff with Cru- started calling me for coffee, for lunch and she started talking to me about God as well. God was working in me! I really liked hanging out with Milena and to be part of all the activities with Every Student. I secretly wished for their happiness and fulfillment. I joined a Bible study group and that's how I started to realize why I'm here on this earth and what is my goal.

I'm thankful to God that He started to reveal himself to me in different ways. One key event for me to truly believe in Jesus was the Revive conference in Germany with many young Christians. There I saw a true Christian faith in action. From then on, I started to change completely. God gave me a new heart, new thoughts, new perspectives, new interests. I feel loved by God, I feel God close to me knowing that I am completely surrendered to His hands, knowing that He is leading me and that He is caring for everything.

What happens, happens for a reason. All the glory belongs to God.

I am very happy that God is using Milena in Verche's life. Milena is a staff member in Cru and from this year she and Zlatko Buckovski will lead one of the SLM (campus) teams in Skopje.
