Please also pray for the preparations of our summer evangelistic project that we plan in July. We are




hoping and praying that the situation with the pandemic will be under control so we can have our summer project and reach many young people with the Gospel.

At one of the meetings, Despina shared with Emilia that we help students grow in the spiritual realm, shared the importance of knowing Jesus as God and Savior, and she shared the gospel. At the last meeting, we asked Emilia if she wanted to meet with us regularly to explore and learn about God together, and she agreed! Despina and I are both very happy and looking forward to seeing God work in Emilia's heart."
