Join us Sunday, June 12th at 12:30pm at John and Patti Pylant's for a cookout celebration of our parents and of being parents!

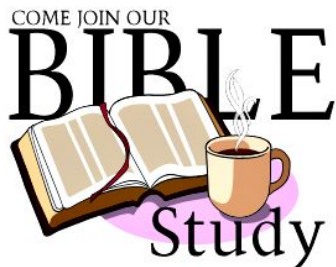
