Hello church family,

The phrase “New Years Resolution” first appeared in a Boston newspaper in 1813, but the practice reaches all the way back to the Babylonian Empire when promises were made to placate their gods.

About 45% of Americans make New Years Resolutions, but 94% of them fail, with most failing by January 7.

The most made resolutions are for a change in diet, exercise, weight loss, making better financial decisions, and learning something new. The number one reason why most New Year Resolutions fail is because they are not specific enough. For example, “I’m going to lose weight” needs to have an actionable plan, like eating more vegetables and less sugar, exercising, and drinking more water.

But even that can be more specific. I’m going to exercise doesn’t set a plan in motion. I’m going to walk 30 minutes four days a week is more likely to stick.

So it is with God. I’m going to make God a priority isn’t specific enough. We

need a plan. “I’m going to make God a priority by reading my Bible at 7:00 five days a week,” is more likely to keep us on track.

Thinking it out and prioritizing God can include a set prayer time each day or night, going to church more consistently, spending less time with people who lead me further away from rather than closer to God.

The good news is that six-ten people who make New Year’s Resolutions are successful, and those who have a workable plan are 10 times more likely to succeed.

God wants to spend more time with us. Let’s make Jesus our top priority, and see what God does with that.

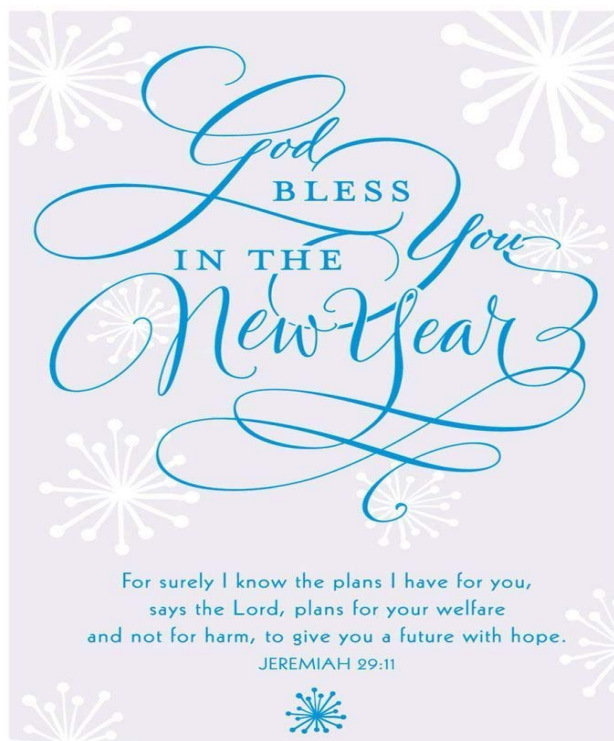
